D. REGISTRATION

Fees

- Fees for the tournament will be \$800. This includes the registration fee (\$670) and the athletic therapist (\$130).
- 2 methods of payment are available:

- There is also an additional fee for the John Paton Pay it Forward, \$1.00 per athlete which will need to be added when submitting payment.
- Registration Deadline - Registration will occur online using the Registration button on the SSA website. The online Forms include a team roster, team photo, and other important documents required by the host. **This is due by Monday, March 16, at noon.**

E. TEAM PICTURES / GAME PHOTOS

- Your team photo session will take place on Wednesday, March 18th.
 - Times are assigned to coordinate with your practice times. Individual player photos will also be taken to be used for their tournament player badge. Please visit the following [link](#) to see times.
 - Mountain West Photography will be on site in our Theatre taking photos.
 - Each team will also be given a complimentary team photo. All player/coach badges and lanyards will be given at the banquet the following morning on Thursday March 19th. This will act as coach/athlete admission into venues.
 - Teams are encouraged to wear their jerseys, or matching team gear.
- Paid photographers will be taking action shots of most games. Each team will be guaranteed at least one game to have coverage. Championship Saturday will have a photographer for all games in the Prairie Winds Gymnasium.

F. PRACTICE SCHEDULE

- Practices will be 1 hour in length and provided at 3 venues on Wednesday March 18th, with the first slot available beginning at 1:30pm, and the last slot beginning at 8:30pm. Please be considerate of the time with teams before and after your practice.

G. OFFICIALS

ABOA

- The Alberta Basketball Officials Association (ABOA) is recognized to provide officials for provincial competitions. Arrangements for officials at all provincial competitions shall be made by the Executive Director and/or appointees of the SSA Executive in cooperation with the ABOA.

Minor Officials

- Minor officials (scorekeepers) are volunteers from Coaldale Prairie Winds. Please treat them with respect and understanding; they are volunteering to help make the event run as smoothly as possible. Each scorekeeping table will be directly supervised by the scoretable supervisor.
- If you or the team has any concerns with the scorekeeping, a member of the coaching staff or teacher supervisor will address it through the Officials and/or Facility Managers. Do not direct comments to the minor officials. Spectators will not address any officials/minor officials at any time, or they will be asked to leave the facility promptly.

H. GRIEVANCES & DISCIPLINE

- There are two key focuses of the Grievance/Discipline Committee at SSA provincials.
 - The first focus is to deal with matters that occur during competition, typically discipline/conduct issues, and appeals that may arise from ejections.
 - The second focus is to handle any other matters that arise that require dispute resolution.
- Grievances need to be brought up to the Grievance Chair first and will then be discussed and concluded by the committee that is made up of an administrator (Megan Leusink), an SSA Commissioner or Staff Member, a head official from ABOA, and two coaches who are not in conflict of interest (selected at the coaches meeting).

I. TEAM ROOMS / CHANGE ROOMS

- Change rooms or classrooms will be assigned and labeled for home and away at each venue. Student hosts and facility managers can assist with required spaces. You will have access to classrooms for 45 minutes prior to game start and 45 minutes post game.
- Prairie Winds or associated school venues are not responsible for any lost or stolen items teams choose to leave unsupervised in change rooms at any venue.
- Change rooms at Prairie Winds are located in the gymnasium on the west wall. These will be available for half-time use. Classrooms will be available during the tournament for before and after games.
- Change rooms at Kate Andrews will be provided classrooms. This is the space available for the pre, half-time and post game. The facility manager and student hosts will direct you to the appropriate space assigned to your team.
- Change rooms at RI Baker are accessible from the gymnasium to be used for half time. Classrooms will be available during the tournament for before and after games.
- Each team will be assigned a student host that can assist them in their needs during the tournament. Whether this is requiring a team room or getting ice, they're your first point of contact.

C. FOOD & BEVERAGE

- A full concession will be located in the common space at Coaldale Prairie Winds Secondary throughout the event. Hot meals and a variety of snacks will be available for purchase.
- A modified concession will be located at RI Baker throughout the event. Hot meals and a variety of snacks will be available for purchase.
- No concession will be available at Kate Andrews.
- Water refill stations are located at all three venues.
- Jerry's Pop Shop and Kona Ice will be available throughout the weekend at staggered times at both RI Baker & Prairie Winds.

D. HOSPITALITY

- Hospitality rooms for coaches and officials are available at all three venues in designated spaces identified with signage. The main space will be available in the Coaldale Prairie Winds staff room. The RI Baker hospitality room will be available in the foods room. KAHS hospitality room will be located in the art room.
- These rooms will be stocked with food, snacks and beverages for coaches and officials.
- Teams will have access to a designated classroom 45 minutes pre-game, and 45 minutes post-game. (Identified on the maps at the end of this package). These are teacher classrooms and require your respect in terms of their privacy and space. They have graciously allowed us to use their space to provide teams a meeting location. Your student host or facility supervisor will open the designated room available for you.

E. PARKING / TRANSPORTATION

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS - School is in session on Wednesday and Thursday, but Friday is a PD day. The below instructions are primarily for Wednesday and Thursday while students are present.

- Prairie Winds
 - Buses can park along the road to the west of the parking lot.
 - Spectators can park in the parking lot adjacent to the school and to the South West.
- Kate Andrews High School
 - Buses can park to the east of the school, along the soccer field road.
 - Spectators can park in front of the school and to the south along the road near the track.
- RI Baker Middle School
 - Bus parking for Wednesday and Thursday will be along 22nd avenue, south of the school.
 - Bus parking for Friday and Saturday can be in the bus loop.

F. TICKETING

- Spectators will be required to pay a daily admission or purchase a tournament pass. Those who purchase a tournament pass will be given a wristband upon verification for admittance during the weekend.

- No secondary Live Streaming is allowed or permitted at this event. Failure to comply may lead to being asked to leave the venue.
- Coaldale Prairie Winds Theatre will be available for teams to gather, relax, and watch the stream from the other schools on our 36 foot screen. This will be available from 11am on Thursday to 6pm on Saturday. Please be respectful of this space and clean up after yourselves as our drama department has graciously permitted its use for the weekend.

H. MERCHANDISE

- Northwest Designs will be set-up in the atrium at Coaldale Prairie Winds Secondary and have SSA Provincial Championship apparel for purchase.

I. TEAM SPORTSMANSHIP

- It is encouraged to get input from all participating teams, coaches, and fans when selecting the team sportsmanship award. By including the criteria for the award in the coaches' package, this will give each team a better understanding of what they should be looking for, as well as the behaviour that is expected of them. This will also give you a better sense of the opposing team's view on attitude, behavior and overall sportsmanship during the game.
- One sportsmanship banner will be given to one team at the SSA Provincial Championship. The team receiving this award will represent the true spirit of sportsmanship, integrity, ethics and fair play
- At the end of each match, two winners will be selected for the SSA Sportsmanship Player of the Game award.
- Throughout the facilities, there will be a QR code that is available for spectators to scan, to nominate anybody that has demonstrated key aspects of sportsmanship throughout the event
- These nominations will be regularly reviewed by the committee throughout the event, and keychains will be distributed to celebrate certain individuals
- These nominations will also aid in the committee's selection of the team sportsmanship recipient.
- The sportsmanship committee or appropriate representative should personally award players their sportsmanship pins, at an appropriate time. When presenting pins to the athletes, identify their name, school, behavior and compliment them on their outstanding and consistent good sportsmanship. If possible, present the tag using the PA system and in front of spectators. This presentation should be at an appropriate break in the action.

J. SPORTSMANSHIP

SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS - NOMINATION BY QR CODE SIGNAGE

- These should be given to individuals who exhibit outstanding displays of integrity, fair play and good sportsmanship. They may be given to athletes, coaches, parents and spectators. These individuals should be recognized for bringing positive presence to the Championship and demonstrating consistent exemplary sportsmanlike behavior. Recipients of a sportsmanship tag should show exemplary behavior.
 - Name, School, Jersey # (if applicable), and description of why they received the award.
 - Athlete/Coaches:
 - Conduct themselves in a positive nature/manner during, before and after the race
 - Be courteous, polite and friendly at all times
 - Show good sportsmanship during the race
 - Show concern, respect or empathy for an opponent-display an outstanding act of sportsmanship, ethics or integrity

SPECTATOR / PARENTS:

- Consistently give positive feedback to players/others
- Welcome opponents
- Positive comments before, during and after the game
- Be helpful to others (ie. willingly offer information about the championship, scheduling, venue locations, etc. to onlookers)

- All 3 venues are equipped with an athletic therapist for any minor injuries or needs. In addition, all 3 venues have an AED available. Site Supervisors will know the location should the need arise.
- Fire extinguishers are available in each venue, along with marked exits should an emergency arise.
- Site Supervisors will be clearly marked with a visible volunteer t-shirt and should be the first point of contact should any need arise. They will direct athletes, coaches, spectators etc to specific locations through the PA system should a fire drill, lockdown or any other emergency arise.
- Fire
 - Activate the nearest fire alarm
 - Evacuate the building using the designated exit routes.
 - Assemble at the designated muster point. (West parking lot (PW))

- Do not re-enter the building until cleared by emergency personnel.
- Lockdown
 - Close all doors and secure the building.
 - Call 911 if it is safe to do so.
 - Await further instructions from site supervisors or law enforcement.
- Severe Weather
 - All spectators will move away from windows and exterior walls into interior rooms and hallways.
 - If evacuation is necessary, proceed to a designated shelter area.
- Power Outage
 - Please remain calm and stay in place.
 - Site Supervisors will assess the situation and provide updates as necessary.
